

EDUCATOR REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS
2021 TENNESSEE HISTORY DAY
DISTRICT 1 and 2 CONTESTS

Educator and student registration opens: Friday, October 2, 2020

Registration deadline: Friday, October 30, 2020, midnight eastern time

Registration Process

Educators should begin the entire registration process by creating their **teacher accounts** first. Once they have done so, they will instruct their students to create their own student accounts. During student registration, students will select their teacher from a drop down menu. This will connect their accounts and give the teacher access to their students' registration information.

Entry Registration

Students will add the information for their entry when they register. Students will either create an independent entry or will link to a group project that their teammate has already created using a special code called a **Project Key/Team Key**. (These terms are used interchangeably in Zfair.)

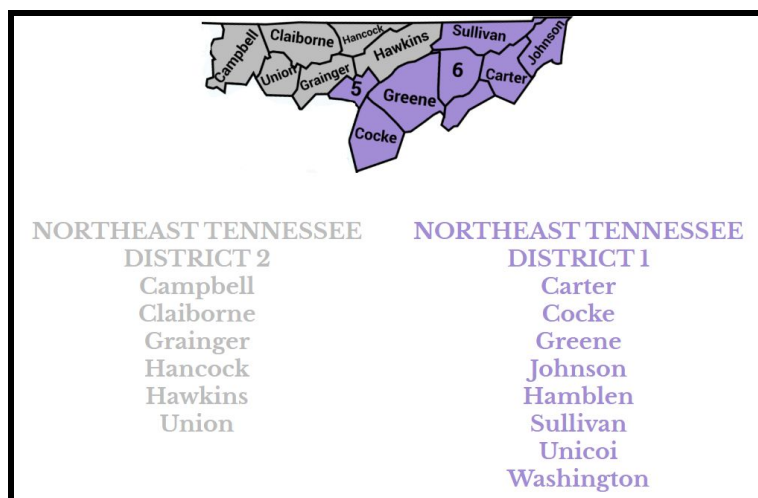
For a group project, have one student create the entry first. When that info is saved, the entry is given a **Project Key/Team Key**, a unique number code. That student will then share the team key with the other group members. The following group members will begin a student account and will enter that same team key for their entry when prompted. Doing so will bring up the title and description for their entry that was filled out by the first group member. Additional group members confirm and are then linked to the entry.
