Educator and Student Registration Opens: **Thursday, December 1, 2022**

Registration Deadline: **Tuesday, January 17, 2023, 11:59 PM ET**

Registration Process

Educators should begin the entire registration process by creating their **teacher accounts** first. Once they have done so, they will instruct their students to create their own student accounts. During student registration, students will select their teacher from a drop-down menu. This will connect their accounts and give the teacher access to their students' registration information.

Entry Registration

Students will add the information for their entry when they register. Students will either create an independent entry or will link to a group project that their teammate has already created using a special code called a **Project Key/Team Key**. (These terms are used interchangeably in the registration system.)

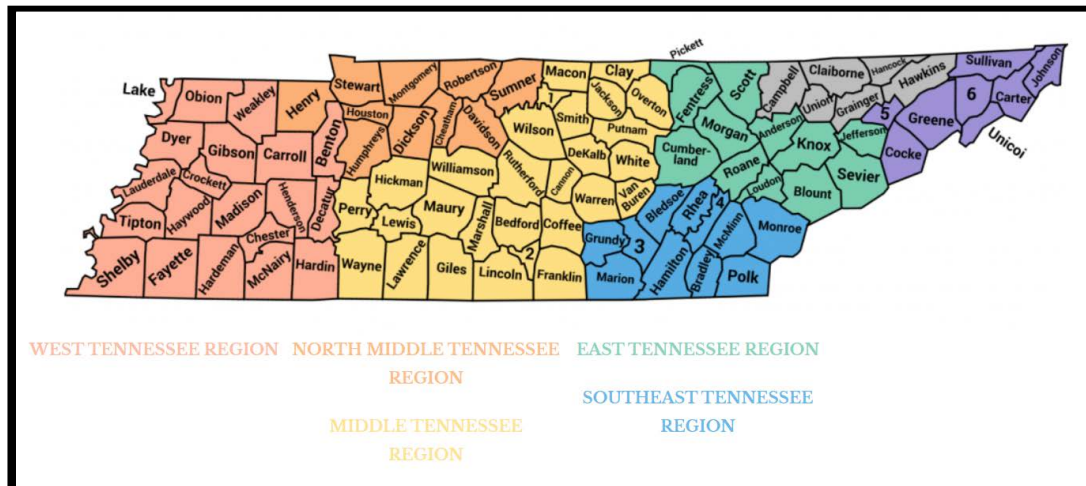
*For a group project, have **one student** create the entry by registering *completely* first. When that information is saved, the entry is given a **Project Key/Team Key**, which is a unique number code. That student will then share the **Project Key/Team Key** with the other group members. Then, the remaining group members will create a student account and enter that same **Project Key/Team Key** for their entry when prompted. Doing so will bring up the title and description for their entry that added by the first group member. Additional group members confirm and are then linked to the entry.

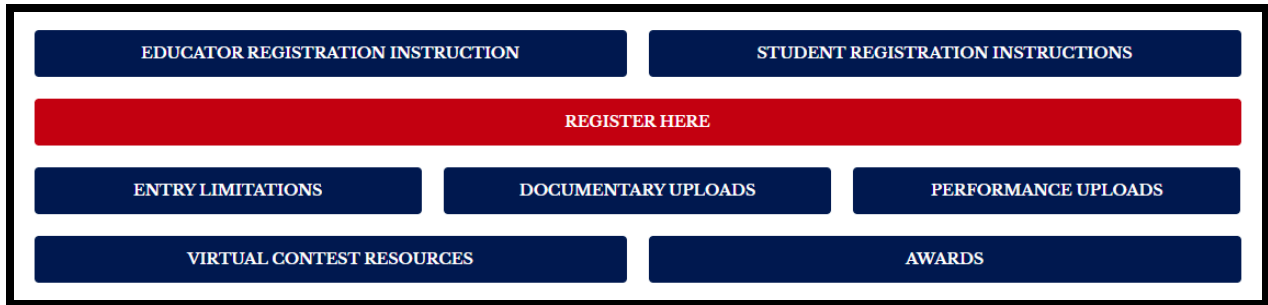

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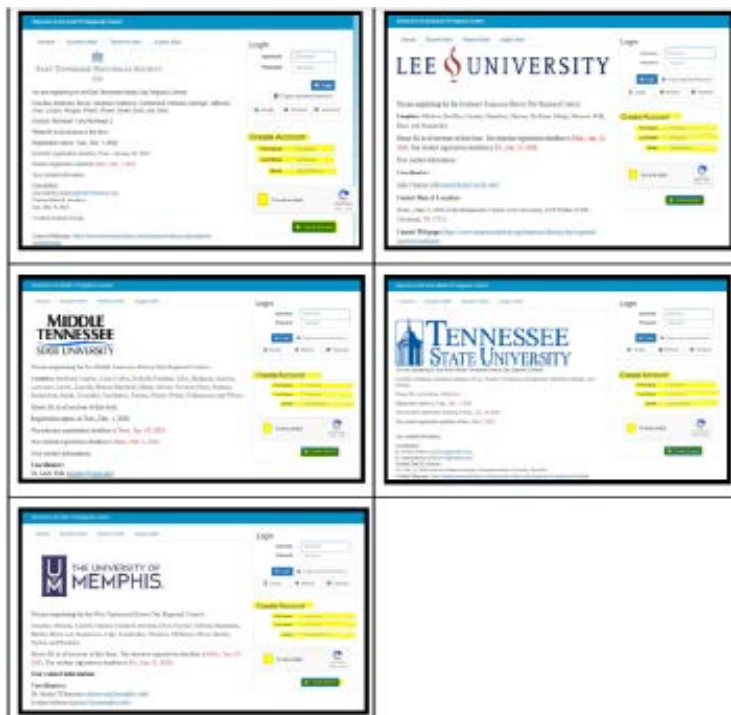

When you are ready to begin registration, select the red **REGISTER HERE** button:




Create an account. Make sure the logo matches the location of your district contest:



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
