- Who should compete in this category?
 - Students who have the time to do the research and to craft that research into a documentary
 - Students who have a grasp of how images and sound work together to tell a story
 - Students who have the technical skills to edit footage and audio
 - Students who have access to technology

To Consider

- Individual vs. Group
 - How will you collaborate with your group? Are you able to do it all at school, or will you need additional time? Can this be done online?

Technology Needs and Options

- Do you have access to video editing software?
- Do you know how to use video editing software?
- Can you arrange for oral history interviews with the technology already have?

Adult Assistance

- You need to follow the guideline of “reasonable help” when it comes to the creation of your exhibit.
 - ACCEPTABLE
 - An adult instructs you on how to use editing software
 - An adult creates an account
 - NOT ACCEPTABLE
 - An adult operates the camera for you

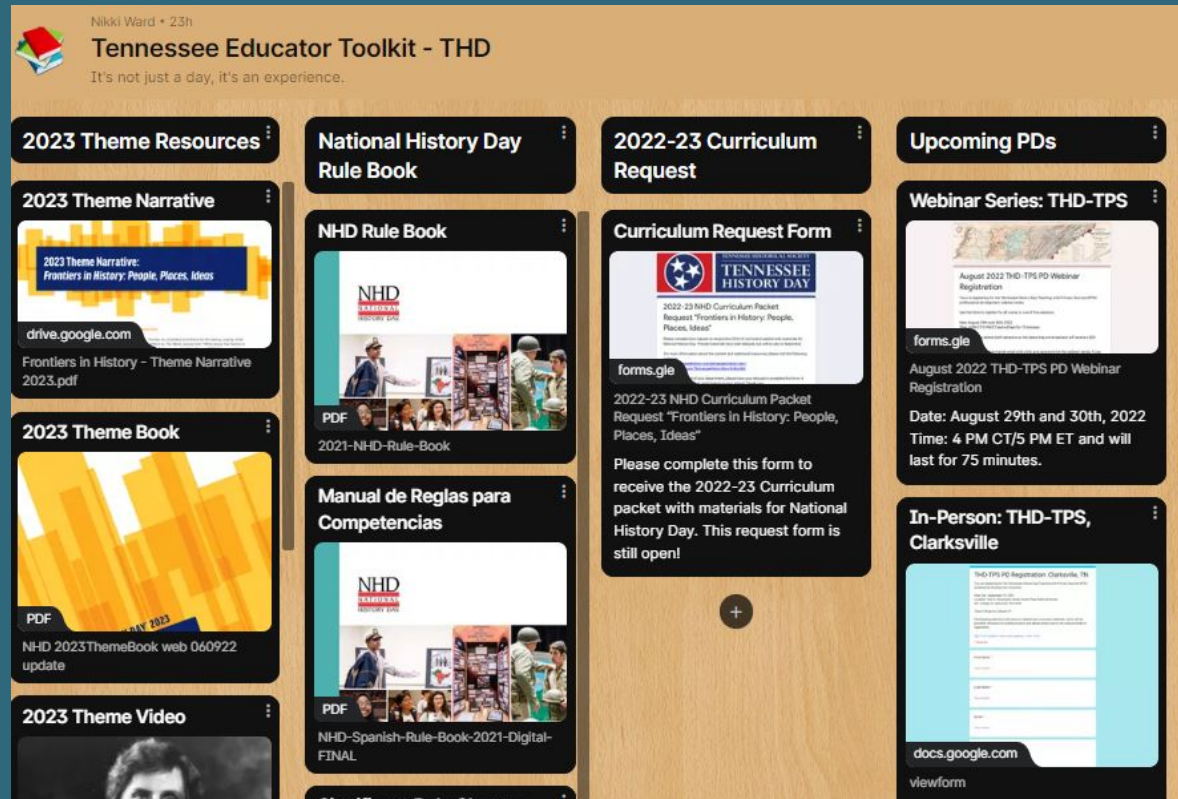

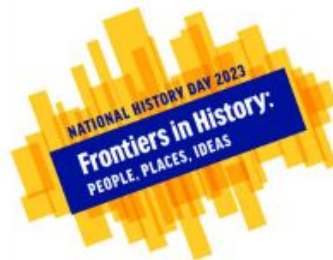
All entries must be completed and submitted by the registration deadline. You will be judged on the project you submit on this date.

Your file must be saved in the following file format: .mp4

If your documentary is taking a very long time to upload, you may want to find a faster internet connection. If your documentary is saved in a format not recognized by SmugMug, it will not upload. Do not wait until the last minute; the server will be very busy and consequently slower.

Do not attempt to log in to SmugMug. You can only upload your file. You will see a big green check when you have been successful.

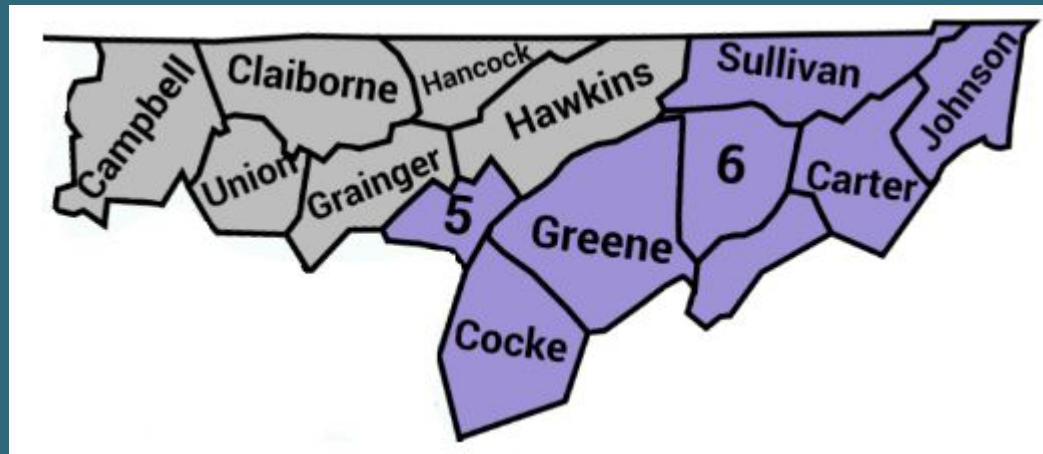

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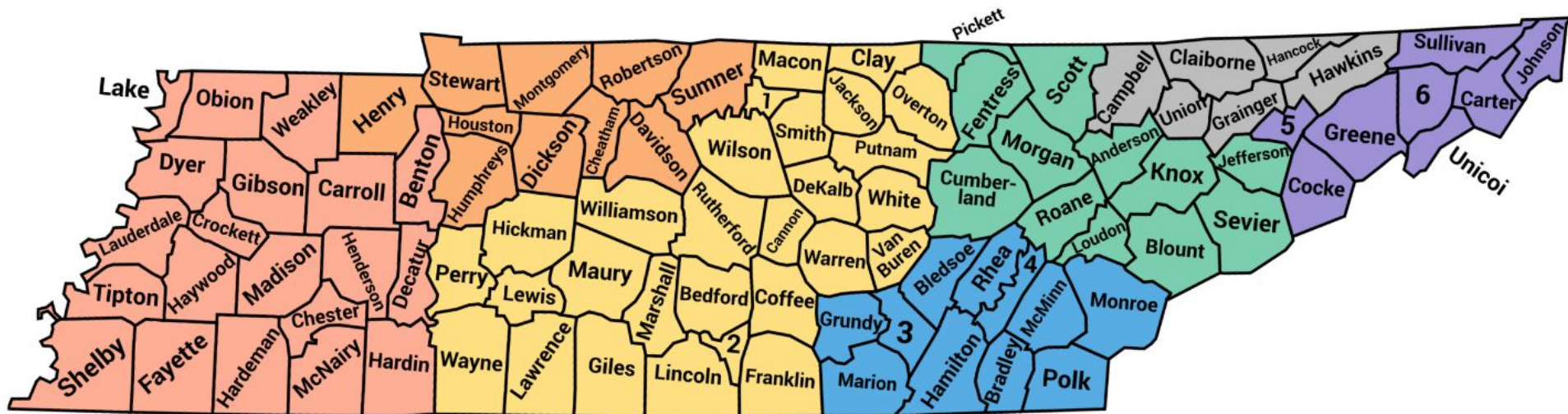
